School co-design workshops
Educational and co-design workshops were conducted between John Keble C of E Primary School, St Claudine's Catholic School for Girls, and Maple Walk School in a joint session on 17th November 2023.

Students were educated on different elements of sustainable and climate resilient highway and landscape design and used this to suggest their own thoughts on the introduction of different Green and Healthy Street interventions outside their schools.

Insight was gained from students on how they use their street, favourite colours and types of plants. These details have shaped the design interventions proposed.

Street decluttering

Parking
27 metres affected outside St. Claudines (equivalent 4 to 5 spaces).
