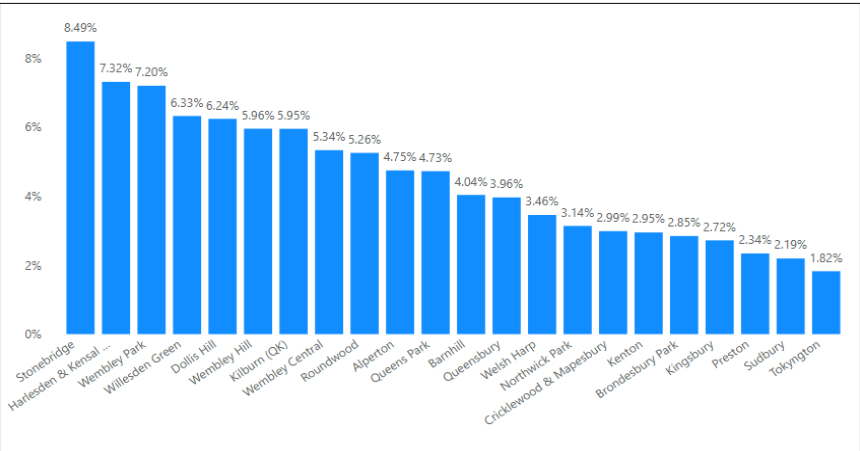
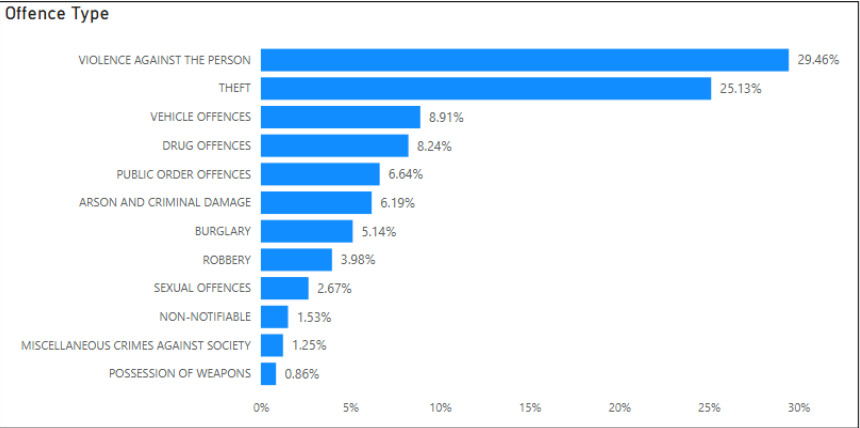
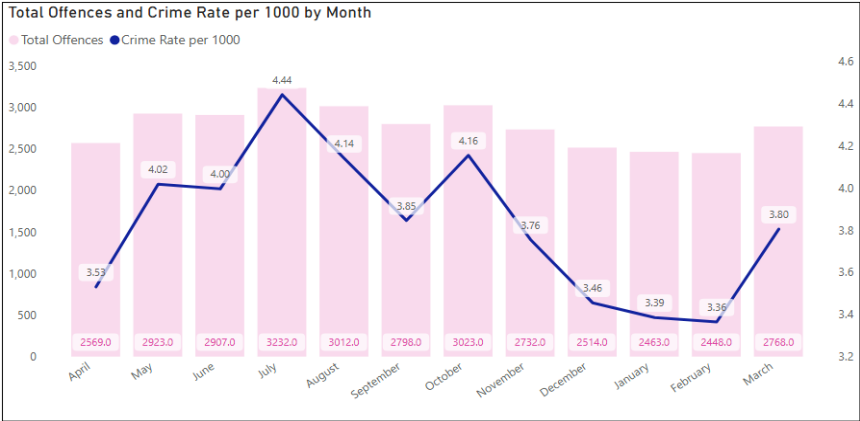

General Trends

Month-on-month Brent saw overall offences follow trends consistent with previous years. The seasonality of the data shows a clear peak in crime rate during the summer months - June, July and August - proceeded by a decrease in December, January and February.

Overall crime rate was 91.78 per 1000 population, ranking Brent 14th amongst all London boroughs.

Offence Types

The most frequent offence type was Violence Against the Person, representing 29.5% of all offences in the year.

Following this was Theft. these two offence types represented a significant majority of 54.6% of all offences in the year.

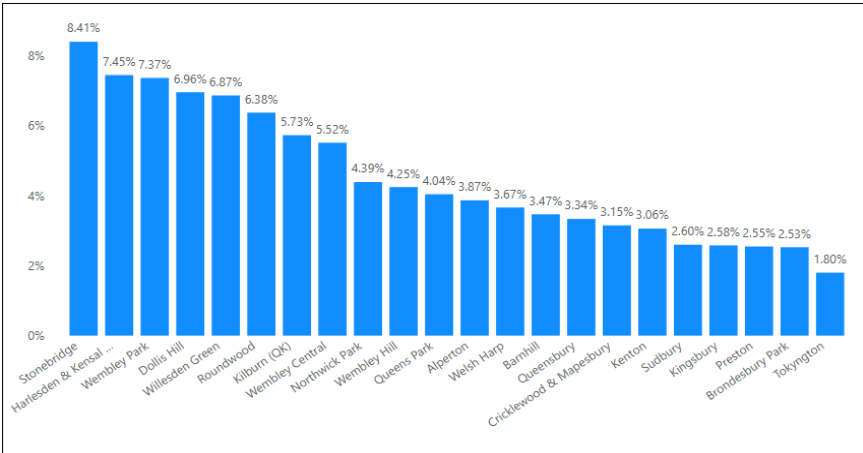
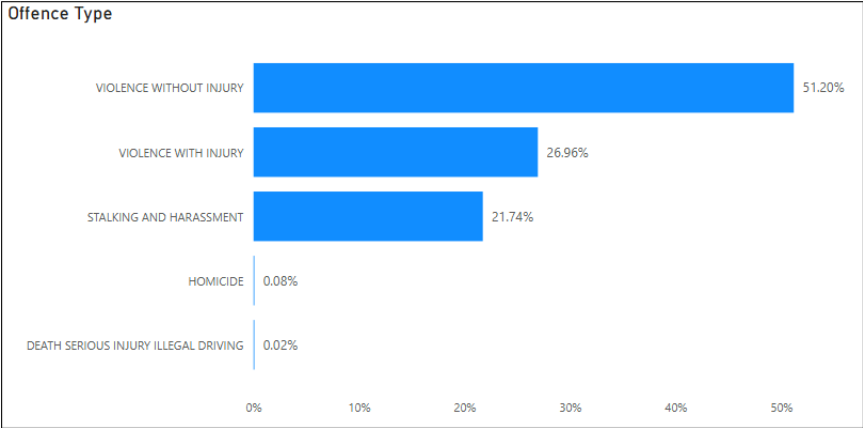
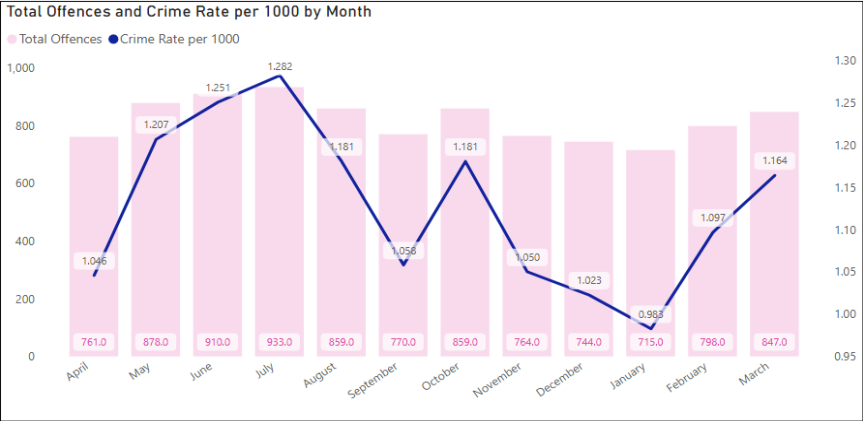

Month-on-month Brent saw overall offences follow trends consistent with previous years. The seasonality of the data shows a clear peak in crime rate during the summer months starting from May until August, proceeded by a decrease from November to January.

The most frequent offence type was Violence Without Injury, representing 51.1% of all Violence Against the Person offences in the year.

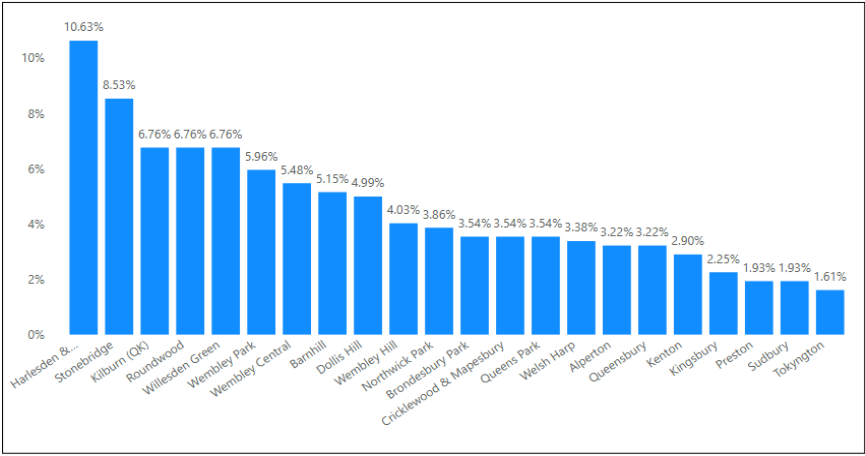
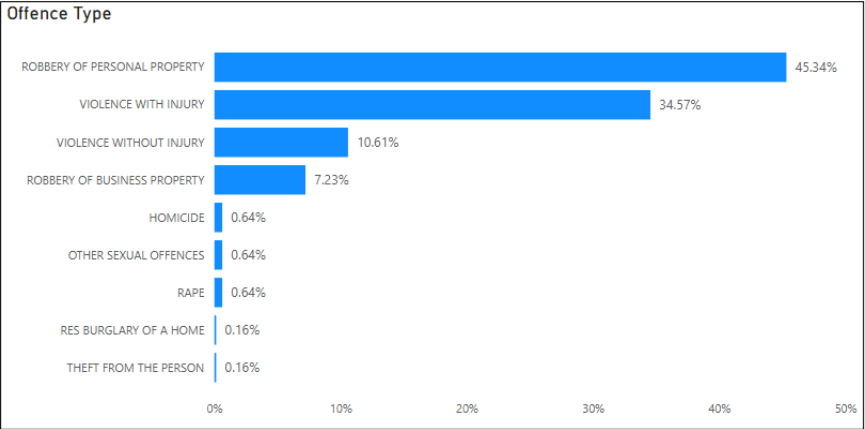
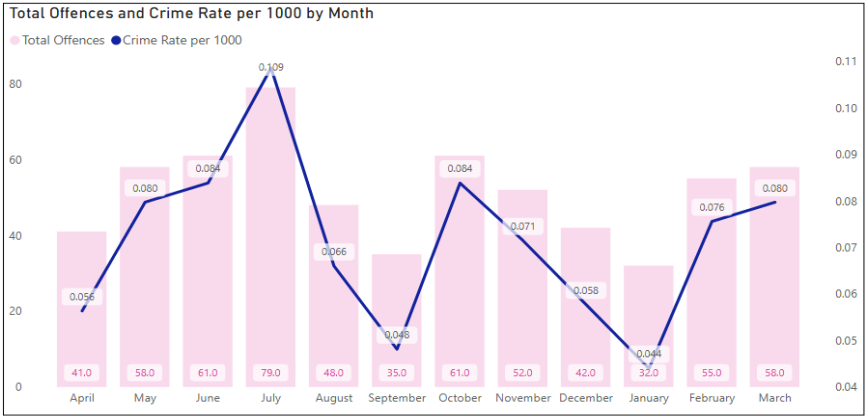

Month-on-month, Knife Crime Offences varied from other crime types in their frequency, with a significant spike in July, and significant decreases in September and January. In the last 12 months there were no seasonal trends compared to the previous year

The most frequent Kinfe-Enabled Offence type was Robbery of Personal Property, representing 45.3% of all Knife-Enabled offences in the year.

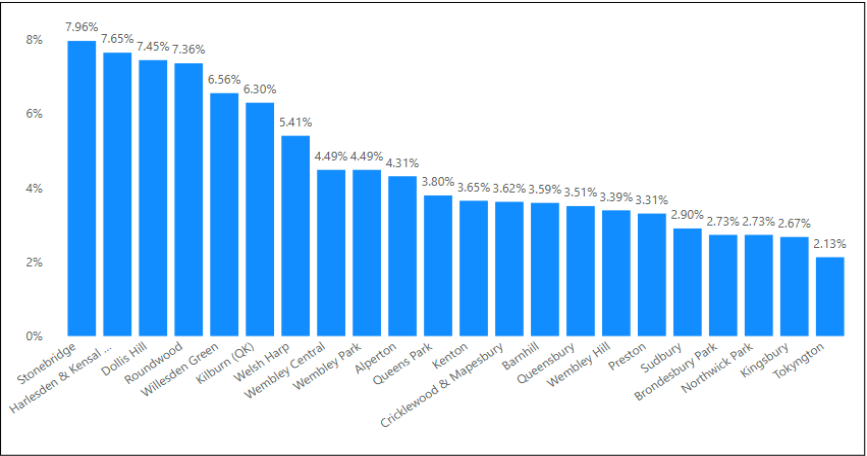
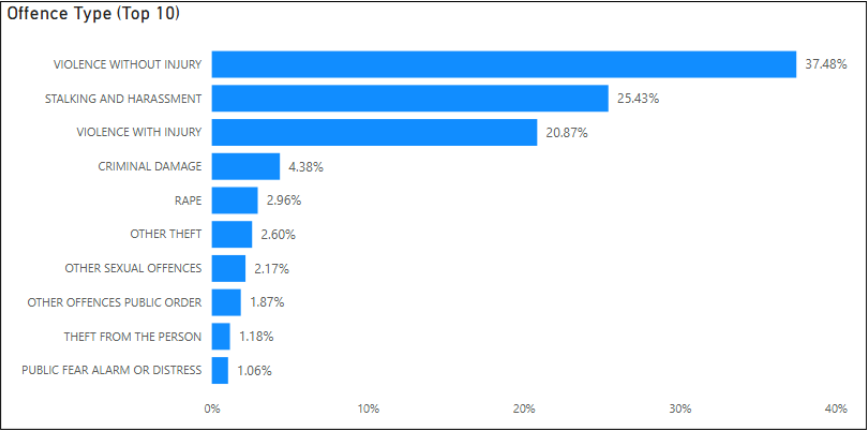
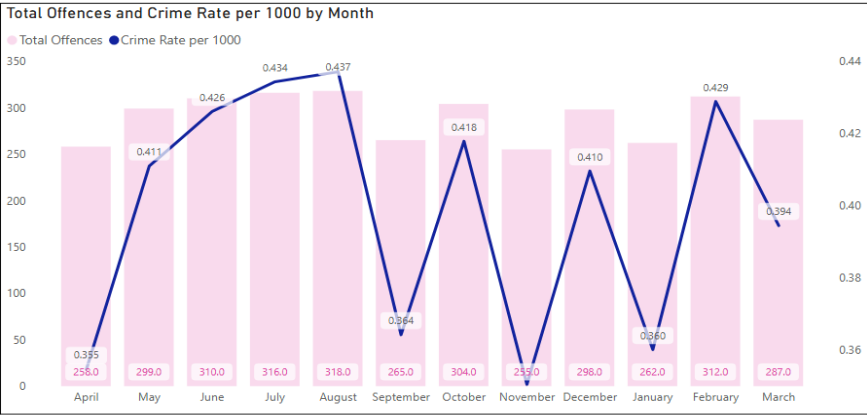

General Trends

Month-on-month, Knife Crime Offences varied from other crime types in their frequency, increasing from April to August, then spiking and falling significantly each month. There is no significant seasonality to Domestic Abuse Offences reported in the last 12 months

Overall crime rate was 9.58 per 1000 population, ranking Brent 10th amongst all London boroughs.

The most frequent Domestic Abuse flagged Offence type was Violence Without Injury, representing 37.5% of all Domestic Abuse offences in the year.

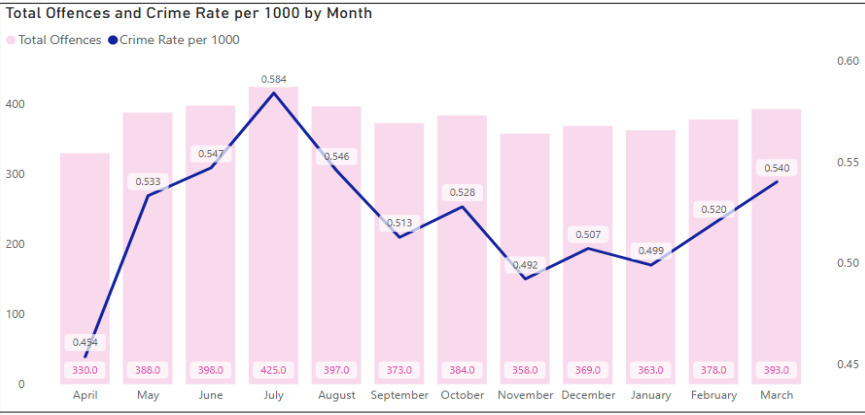
Following this was Stalking and Harassment, representing 25.4% of Violence Against the Person offences in the year.

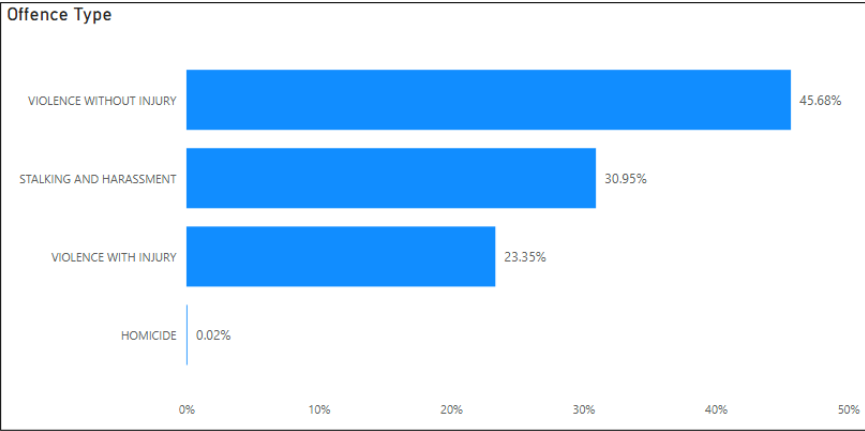


General Trends

Overall crime rate was 12.5 per 1000 population, ranking Brent 9th amongst all London boroughs.

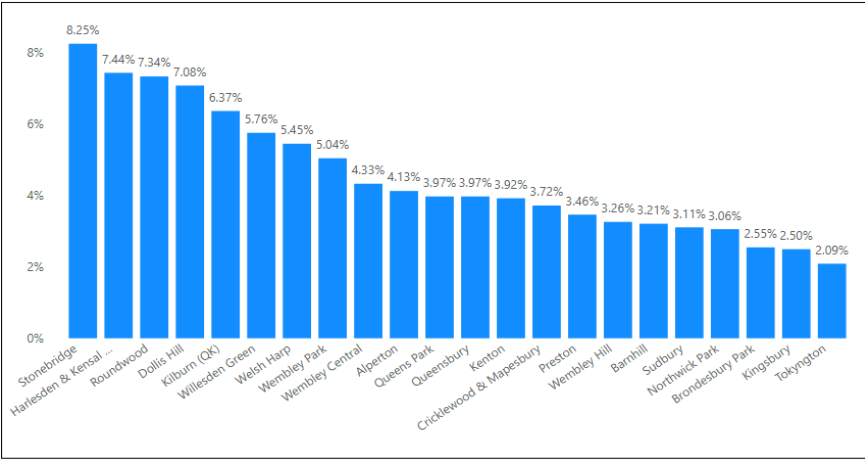

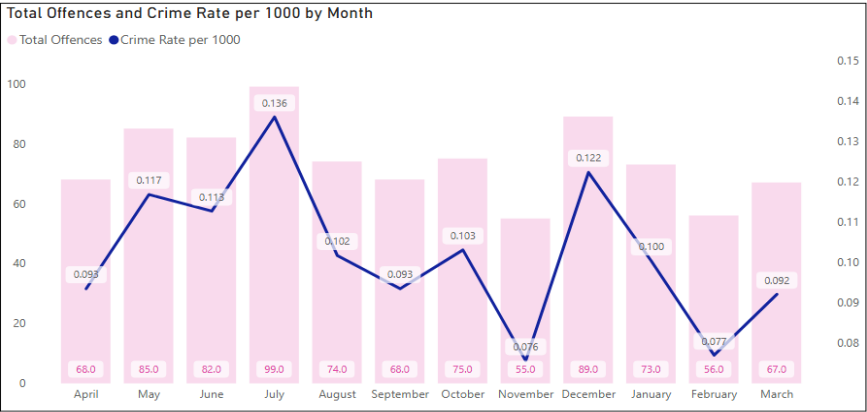

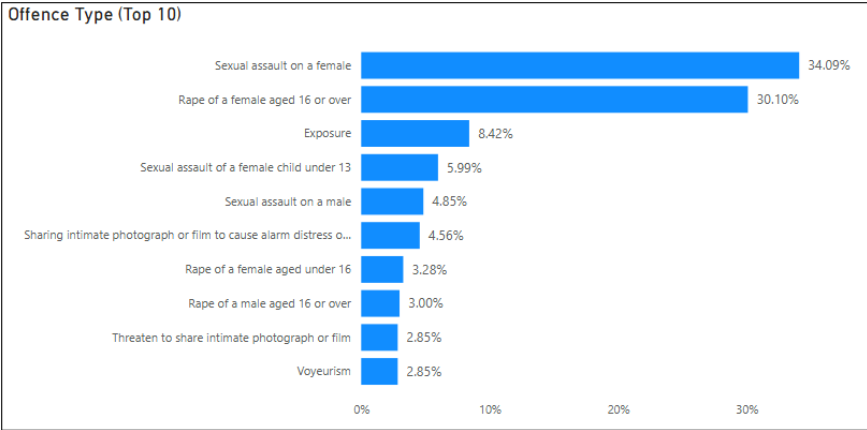


General Trends

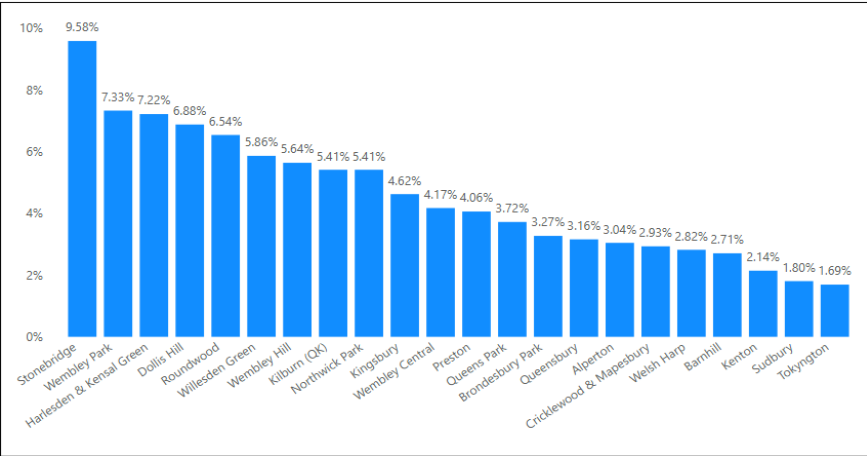

The most frequent Sexual Offences was Sexual Assault on a Female, representing 34.1% of all Sexual offences in the year.

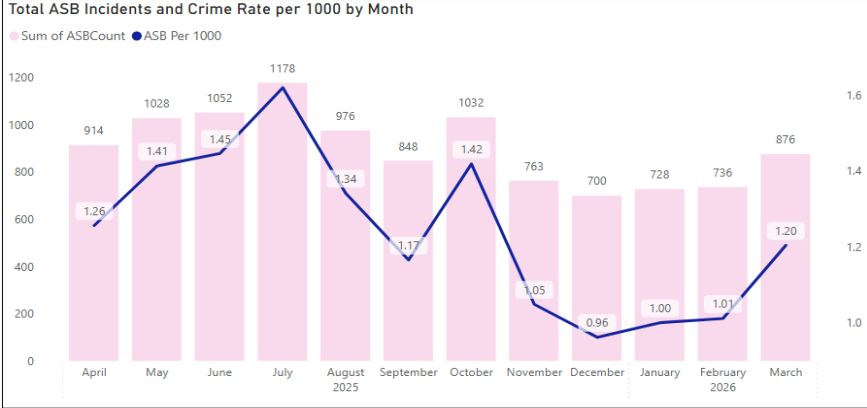

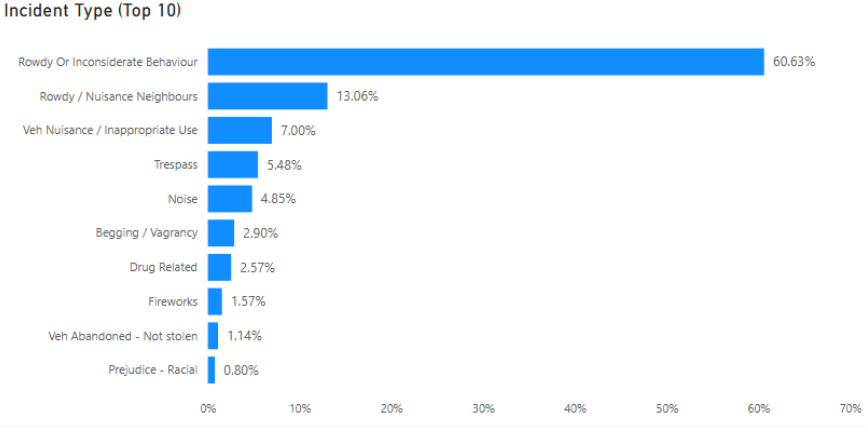


General Trends

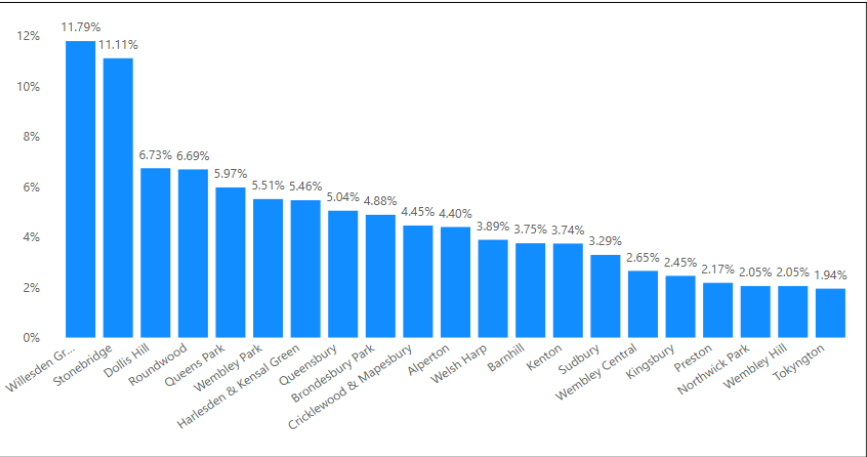

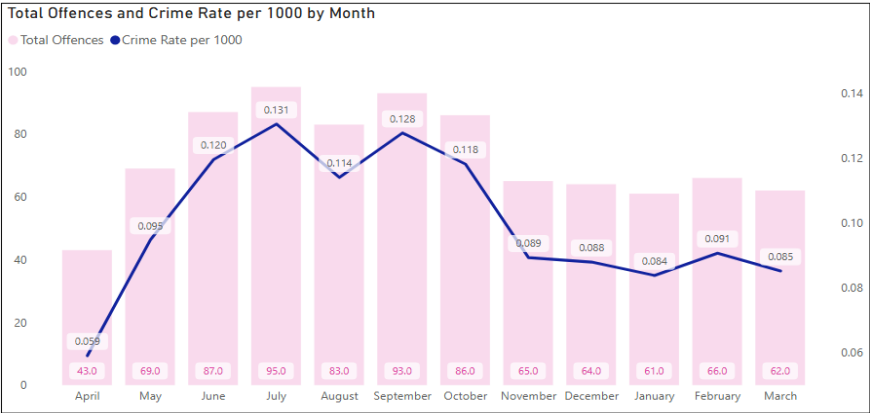

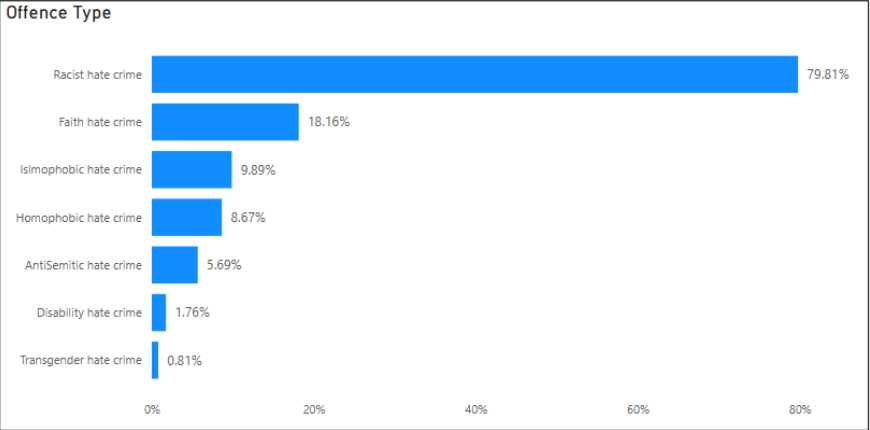


General Trends

Overall crime rate was 2.4 per 1000 population, ranking Brent 6th amongst all London boroughs.

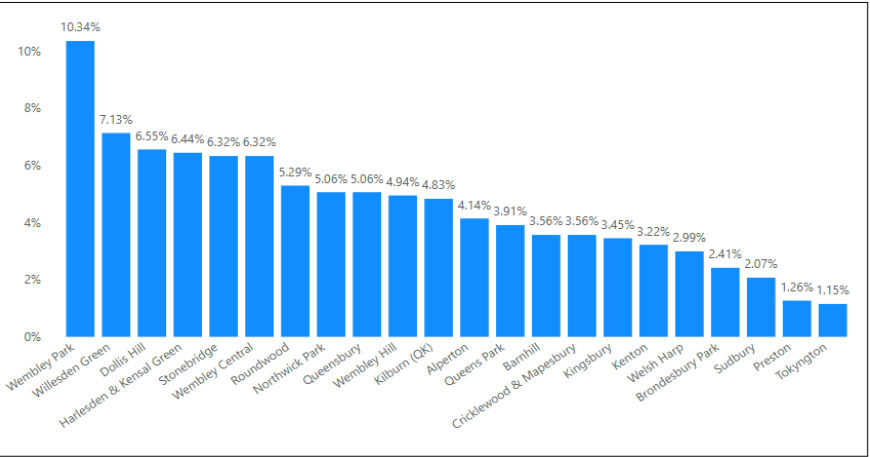
