**Proposed School Safety Scheme**  
Rising Stars Nursery

This document outlines our proposals for a school safety scheme near Rising Stars Nursery on Princes Avenue, NW9. Please read through the information in this document and then complete and return the enclosed questionnaire - **postage is free**. Alternatively this document is also available for completion online at <https://haveyoursay.brent.gov.uk> responses from within the consultation area will only be considered. The closing date for the return of the questionnaire is: **15 July 2022**.

**Why are we proposing this change?**

The Council has received complaints of obstructive parking at the entrance of Rising Stars Nursery. Officers have identified mitigation measures to improve road safety outside of the Nursery.

The aim of the scheme is to:

- Prevent obstructive parking and dangerous parking
- Improve visibility and traffic flow
- Improve road safety for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists, particularly the vulnerable road users

Details of the proposed scheme and the area affected are shown on the enclosed drawings.

**What are the proposed improvements?**

The proposal is to introduce a School Keep Clear marking outside of the school property boundary on Princes Avenue, NW9. Operational Monday to Friday 8:15am-9:15am and 2:30pm to 4:30pm.

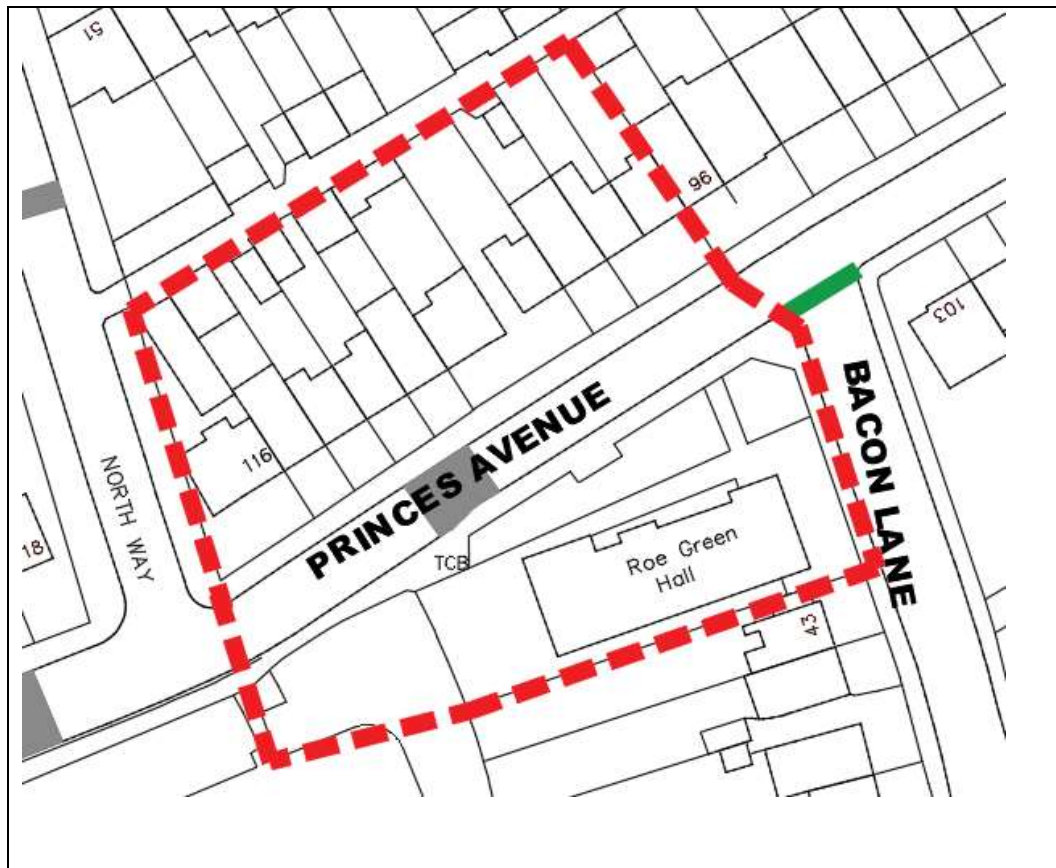
School Keep Clear markings are shown as yellow zigzags outside of schools. This marking prohibits vehicles to park or even **stop** to set down passengers whilst the restrictions are in force.

The markings will prohibit vehicles from parking or stopping outside the school gates on Princes Avenue, reducing congestion and improving road safety for all road users.
