needed to save around

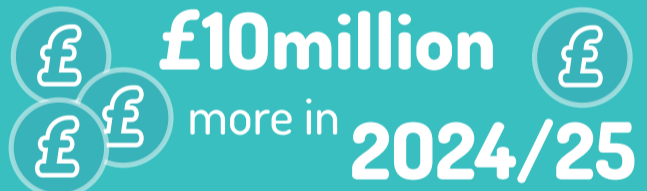
£200m

Council Tax by **4.99%**, of
which **2%** would
go towards adult
social care
