**We are excited to invite you to our second public consultation for Bridge Park. This consultation will focus on the proposed closure of Bridge Park Leisure Centre, the revised plans for the site, and the latest updates on the Hillside Corridor.**

Since our last exhibition, we have taken on board your feedback, and there are now important updates to share. We understand that Bridge Park has played an important role in the Stonebridge community for many years. However, the current building is outdated and no longer meets the needs of local people. Extensive investment would be required to keep it open and the reasons why the Council is proposing that the leisure centre will close are explained more fully in the consultation material available on the Council's website.

Our vision is to create a new, modern leisure facility that better serves the community, along with new affordable homes and spaces for education and business. This will ensure that Stonebridge continues to thrive for future generations.
